SHAPE Week – **S**inging in **H**armony **A**nd **P**ursuing **E**xcellence – June 7-13, 2020 A program for ages 13 and up. During this week we offer classes for all abilities (beginner through song writing). SHAPE week moves a little faster due to the age of all the students. Final registration for students attending SHAPE Week will be held from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. on Sunday June 7, at the office (see map at the end of this pack). Students attending SHAPE week can remain on campus for Academy week by registering for both weeks.

DORMITORY AND RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM

The goal of our on-campus dormitory and residential program is to insure the safety and welfare of each student. The residential program support staff will help the student make new friends and foster old friendships, while providing supervision and support services to assure a safe, enjoyable time at the Academy.

On-campus dormitory students MUST BE 8 YEARS OF AGE or older, with the ability to take care of their basic needs (showering, doing hair, brushing teeth, etc.). Our dorm staff will always be there to offer assistance if needed. Separate male and female dorms serve the students and staff. The dormitories are bunk bed style. The student will need to furnish linens, pillow, blankets, personal items, etc. Please refer to the items listed in the 'To Bring' section of this Family Information packet. Some dorm rooms are designed to share a full bathroom, including shower, commode and lavatory, with the adjoining room. A community shower and restroom in each dormitory serves the general population.

Students are required to keep a clean and neat dorm room.

Dormitory students have a required dorm check-in and lights-out policy as follows:

Age 8 to 12 must be in dorm by 10:00 p.m. lights out by 10:30 p.m. Age 13 and over must be in dorm by 10:30 p.m. lights out by 11:00 p.m.

TIDBITS OF IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Upon arrival, follow the parking signs and report directly to the office. See the map at the end of this pack. Follow the orange arrows and park in the grass.
- NO PARKING IN FRONT OF THE OFFICE.
- Please bring your luggage, personal items, and any remaining fees that you owe.
- After registration, report to your dorm for room assignment. Staff will be available to assist with your luggage and check-in.
- Roommates are assigned by age, according to space availability. Students may request a roommate in their age group; however, THE ACADEMY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO MAKE FINAL BED ASSIGNMENTS.
- After dinner each Sunday, students will assemble in the Lodge for introductions, orientation and meet and greet.

- Dorm meetings will be held by the dorm supervisors and staff after assembly.
- SONGBIRDS & SPARROWS classes are offered for one week ONLY June 15-20, 2020. Parents are encouraged to pre-register for these classes, as space is limited, but they can wait until Monday, June 15, to check in at classroom 3 between 8:15-8:30 AM. Please note spaces are limited. A spot for your child will <u>only</u> be held if full payment accompanies your registration.
- Both Songbirds and Sparrows will ATTEND FOR A HALF DAY ONLY. STUDENTS MUST BE PICKED UP AT NOON. CHILD CARE IS NOT PROVIDED BY THE ACADEMY.

DORM CHECK OUT TIME ON Saturday, June 20 is 11:30 a.m. Dorm staff will be available for assistance. Parents please plan to pick up your child by 11:30 a.m. at the Academy. LUNCH AND TRANSPORTATION TO THE CHURCH ARE ON YOUR OWN. Local restaurants are listed at the end of this packet. There will be no lunch served at the Retreat on Saturday, June 20.

ALL STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO CLEAN THEIR DORM ROOM <u>PRIOR</u> TO CHECK-OUT. ROOMS MUST BE CLEANED & VACATED NO LATER THAN 11:30 A.M. PLEASE, DO NOT LEAVE CLOTHES OR OTHER ITEMS. THE CAMPUS WILL NOT BE OPEN OR AVAILABLE AFTER THE CLOSING PROGRAM.

DO RE MI SONGBIRDS, SPARROWS, MOMMA AND POPPABIRD

A half day commuter program for children age 3-7 is available the week of June 15-20 only. Students will be dropped off in their classroom by 8:30 and picked up in their classroom by noon. Please note – placement in these classes will be determined by enrollment.

Child care services are not provided by the Academy; therefore, all Songbirds & Sparrows must be picked up by noon. Under no circumstances will these students be allowed to remain on campus unsupervised.

One parent of each Songbird or Sparrow may register for a FREE class. We will offer a special adult class for the parents wishing to remain on campus during the morning. This free class will end at noon so you can pick up your child. Any parent wanting to attend a more advanced class may test into that class and attend free until noon each day.

- **❖** Worship service Sunday, June 14, at 11 a.m. in the Lodge, followed by lunch.
- Family & Friends are invited to attend nightly singings and the Sunday Worship service.

- ❖ Special concert by our vocal instructor and Southern Gospel singing great Jonathan and Jordan Wilburn, will be held on Thursday evening June 18, after dinner. Parents are invited. Jonathan is one of the finest Southern Gospel lead singers ever, and we are honored for him to teach with us at Do Re Mi. His concerts are a worship time to glorify and honor God! He is a former lead singer with Gold City Quartet for over 26 years and has been voted the best of the best!

COMMUTER CLASS

A commuter program is available for those students who wish to drive in daily for the day OR night classes. This class is FREE for our Veterans. Meals are not included in the registration fee, but they may be purchased for the week or daily.

All students who commute must check in upon arrival on campus. Likewise, check—out is required when the student leaves campus. The check in/out location, staffed by a dorm staff person, is located at the Lodge corner of the Boys Dorm (see map). We have a limited number of RV spots for families wishing to camp on campus during the week. Call about reserving these, as they have been completely full every year.

• What class should I register for? On campus both weeks is the best value. There are some age restrictions for each class. Be sure you meet these:

On Campus SHAPE week	Age 13 and up
On Campus Academy week	Age 8 and up
Day Commuter SHAPE week	Age 13 and up
Day Commuter Academy week	Any Age
Night Commuter	Any Age
Songbird and Sparrow	Age 3 and up

- Is my child a Songbird, Sparrow or day commuter? Songbirds and Sparrows are all our half day classes. We divide the groups by age once all registration is complete. Be sure to pre-register as these classes have been completely full each year. If your child is mature enough to engage in classroom activities for an entire school day they are welcome to register for the day commuter class.
- If my child is a Songbird or Sparrow can I attend class? Yes. This year we will have a new special beginner adult class that parents can attend free. We will also allow parents to attend the advanced classes in the morning.
- Can I change class? Yes. We want you to get the most from this experience. If you would like to change from commuter to on campus, please let us know. Also, if you need to move up or down, let us know. We will make the change. We encourage students let us know if they need to be in a different class.
- When should I come to the Academy? If you cannot make the times listed below please contact us to make other arrangements.

• Will there be classes Saturday, June 13? Yes. There will be a classes for students signed up for SHAPE week. New this year Registration for Academy week will be Sunday, June 14. Note: Anyone coming to the singing can check in the dorms after the singing June 13.


- Why do I need to give permission for my child to ride the bus? During Academy week all students will leave campus on Friday to do a walk thru of the closing program at the First Baptist Church Hartsville.
- What if I have special dietary restrictions? We will attempt to make accommodations for your needs if possible. Our kitchen staff will store special food you bring daily and heat it up for meal time. While we cannot meet every request but we do try and work with each family. Please contact us beforehand to discuss.
- What is the Do Re Mi Museum? Part of our mission is to preserve the heritage of the shape notes. We have started a museum that is located in the office building. Students are encouraged visit. It is open daily during both weeks of the music school and by appointment other times. If you would like more information or would like to help develop this, please email us.
- What is the house system? Every student is placed in one of four houses. Stamps, Speer, Gaither or Vaughan. They work together daily to encourage each other and earn points toward the memorial trophy which is presented to the house with the most points at the end of the week.
- Can my friends come? Yes, we encourage friends and family to come to the Academy nightly at 7 PM and join in the singing. We ask anyone going to class be a registered student.
- What if my child needs to leave? Every year we have students that need to leave campus during the week. A parent must sign a student out and back in any time they leave campus.
- What is the shaving cream fight? All students who want to participate gather in the field out front and spray each other with shaving cream. There are several pictures on our website.
- What if my child takes medicine? At registration fill out the medicine form, and the dorm staff will keep the medicine locked up and help each child get their medicine at the correct times. Please send medication in a sealed plastic bag with your child's name on it.
- What is "Shout out time"? Daily before lunch students are given the opportunity to give a shout out to someone or something that was good that day. It is a special fun and encouraging time.


